 3. The roundel symbol is proportional to the one on drawing P 612.
 4. The colours are as follows:-
Main sign background _____ White
Top panel background _____ Blue
Top panel legend _____ White
Legend beneath route symbol _____ Black
Route symbol and border _____ Black
Prohibitory Roundel as shown on P 612 with added white border
 5. The illumination of the sign must accord with the requirements of the current 'Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions'.
 6. The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are given in stroke widths based on the place name text height (i.e. $1s/w = 1/4x'$ -height).
 7. The sign is designed in accordance with the current design rules.
 8. The order of languages may be reversed if required.
